

**JOB DESCRIPTION
LIFEGUARD

Wellness 360, a leader in personal, corporate, hotel and residential wellness, spa and fitness programs is seeking knowledgeable, personable, and compassionate massage therapists. We are offering opportunities for excellent compensation (commensurate with education and experience) in a growing company where you and your work are valued and respected; as we succeed, our entire team is rewarded. Our primary focus is to work with motivated licensed massage therapists who are able to work flexible hours and provide the highest level of skills and customer service. Beyond that, we are looking for creative, innovative individuals who wish to use their talents to create unique programs, services and treatments to offer to a very discerning clientele.

Purpose: The Lifeguard is responsible for ensuring the safety of pool patrons through an adherence of facility, operational and customer services standards.

Position Duties:

- Enforcement of all NYC Department of Health, NYS Laws and Regulations and facility rules
- Provide any and all care to clients in distress within the limits of the Lifeguard's training and the standards established by the ARC, AHA and the NYC Dept. of Health
- Report for each shift on time, allowing time prior to schedule shift to check first aid supplies, rescue equipment, pool chemistry, and any other tasks necessary for save pool operations
- The Lifeguard on duty should not leave the pool for any reason, unless relieved by another certified Lifeguard. In the event of a personal emergency -- if there is no certified Lifeguard to provide coverage -- first notify your supervisor, then close the pool ensuring that all swimmers have left
- The Lifeguard should have no distractions while attending to the pool. There should be no reading, music (external or headphones), phone use or extended conversations with clients or coworkers while on shift
- Customer service is of utmost importance. Wellness 360 expects all Lifeguards to be courteous and helpful towards all clients and pool patrons without sacrificing their ability to provide conscientious pool supervision.
- Lifeguard needs to report all accidents, injuries, incidents and complaints to supervisor immediately and complete the Wellness Incident Report immediate thereafter.

Other Responsibilities:

- Lifeguards will provide in-water supervision to participants who have enrolled in Wellness 360 created and certified programs
- Lifeguards will provide swimming instruction to participants enrolled in Wellness 360 created and certified programs
- Participation in all in-house training and emergency drills
- All other related duties as assigned by supervisor

- All Wellness 360 programs will be conducted while pool is closed to other patrons or while there is an additional Lifeguard on duty

Maintenance:

- Regular testing and recording of chlorine and pH levels as prescribed by CPO on duty and NYC Dept. of Health regulations
- Immediately inform CPO of adjustments necessary to pool chemistry
- Inspect all first aid, safety equipment and other pool equipment prior to starting shift. Report any equipment problems, chemical needs or broken or missing equipment to supervisor immediately
- Lifeguard should prepare the pool for upcoming programs and then stow all equipment not being used after the completion of the program. These duties should not interfere with pool supervision
- Lifeguards will perform the cleaning and maintenance of the pool as prescribed by CPO or Supervisor. This includes the cleaning of pool proper and surrounding deck

Requirements:

- Prior to employment, you must have acceptable and current certifications in the following American Red Cross courses (or equivalent):
- Lifeguarding - in the New York City Region
- CPR for the Professional Rescuer – which includes Adult and Child AED
- First aid if not included in Lifeguard Training course material

Compensation: Base fee is determined by certifications and experience and will be outlined during the application process. Lifeguards receive separate additional compensation for Wellness 360 water and swimming programs
